## **Grace Period For Medical Certificates**

CTA (California Transportation Association) has been working closely with the DMV over the last week primarily on the topic of medical certificates expiring. It was reported, as of today, that the 60-day grace period for expiring CDLs also applies to expiring medical certificates.

During this period, due to the closure of local DMV offices, the limited availability of appointments and the continued movement of essential goods, drivers may temporarily operate with expired medical certificates and CDLs without the risk of being cited by law enforcement authorities.

Nevertheless, the State is required to regain its CDL and medical licensing status as soon as the national emergency ends or the DMV resumes regular operations.
